

The Role of Amberheart's Scientific Leadership Council (SLC)

Amberheart's Scientific Leadership Council (SLC) will be a stand-alone body comprising top medical specialists in the field of breast cancer.

The role of the SLC will be to provide medical and scientific guidance and support to Amberheart through developing and disseminating knowledge regarding prevention, diagnosis and treatment of breast cancer; advocating for breast cancer patients; and increasing the awareness levels and involvement of basic and clinical researchers and practitioners.

In order to allow for effective flows of communication, leadership of the SLC shall gain a seat on the Board of Directors and the leadership of the Board will participate in meetings of the SLC. It is expected that Members of the Scientific Leadership Council will be clinicians, research scientists, and nurses from centers recognized for performing outstanding research and providing excellent care for breast cancer patients.

Members will act as speakers at Amberheart seminars and symposia, and will provide editorial oversight to publications. It is also expected they will help in developing the medical branch of

Amberheart's programming as well as in creating a highly specialized, professionally governed and charity.

The SLC will meet at least once, and up to twice, a year, as needed. Membership requires attending semi-annual meetings, serve on at least one standing committee and be willing to work with Amberheart staff, as needed, on a variety of program issues. SLC members serve in a volunteer capacity unless they are involved directly in the realization of grant and/or research project where honoraria may be assigned.
